

Legion of Mary Dublin Primary Schools Competition 2022

The Legion of Mary invites all Dublin primary school students to participate in this special competition to create artwork to honour “Mary the Mother of Jesus”.

The competition is open to all schools in Dublin.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The competition is open to Dublin school children from junior infants to sixth class as per September of 2021. There are three age categories to enter: 4 to 6 years; 7-10 years; 11-13 years. A teacher must enter a child / group of children from their school. Before doing so, teachers must have parent/guardian’s permission. Parents can also submit their child’s entry.
2. We will accept entries submitted by email or letter.(by email please use school@legiomariae.ie and for postal entries please mail to

3. However we are not responsible for late, lost or delayed entries.
4. This includes network computer hardware or software failures of any kind that may delay or restrict entry to the competition.
5. All entries should respond directly to the theme of the competition – to draw/paint an image of Mary the Mother of Jesus.
6. The drawings/paintings must be portrait A4.

7. We will not accept works in other formats/larger sizes.
8. All artworks must be two-dimensional.
9. Entries can be sent in digital form in full colour.
10. They should be image or PDF files of a high resolution (3MB).
11. A cover note or email must indicate that by submitting an entry you accept these terms and conditions.
12. The competition opens for entries from 6th of May 2022.
13. The deadline for entries is midnight on 31st May 2022.
14. Only one image per entrant may be submitted.
15. The judges' decisions will be final and binding.
16. We will notify winners via their school/parents by 17th June.
17. If we cannot contact a winner, or a prize remains unclaimed 10 days after being notified, it will be forfeited.
18. We may choose then a new winner for that prize.
19. There will be **3 overall winners** in the competition, one in each age category, who will receive a prize of a **60 euro book voucher**. There will be **three runners-up in each category** who will each receive prizes of **20 euro book vouchers** and the **overall winner's school in each category** will receive a prize of a **100 euro book voucher for their school**.
20. The best 12 pieces of artwork including the 3 abovementioned winners will be put on display in the Legion of Mary World Headquarters in Dublin.

21. All entrants will receive a small gift pack from the Legion of Mary.
