- To provide an environment for salt loving creatures, e.g. fish....


### Salt is vital for life and for quality of life!

What does light do for us?


- Shows us the way

Don't hide behind others!


If you have an opinion to share – let someone hear it!



<u>Jesus said:</u> No one after lighting a lamp puts it under the bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house.








Can you brighten anyone's day today?

<u>Jesus said:</u> In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven.




