The Rublev Icon depicts an image of the Holy Trinity.

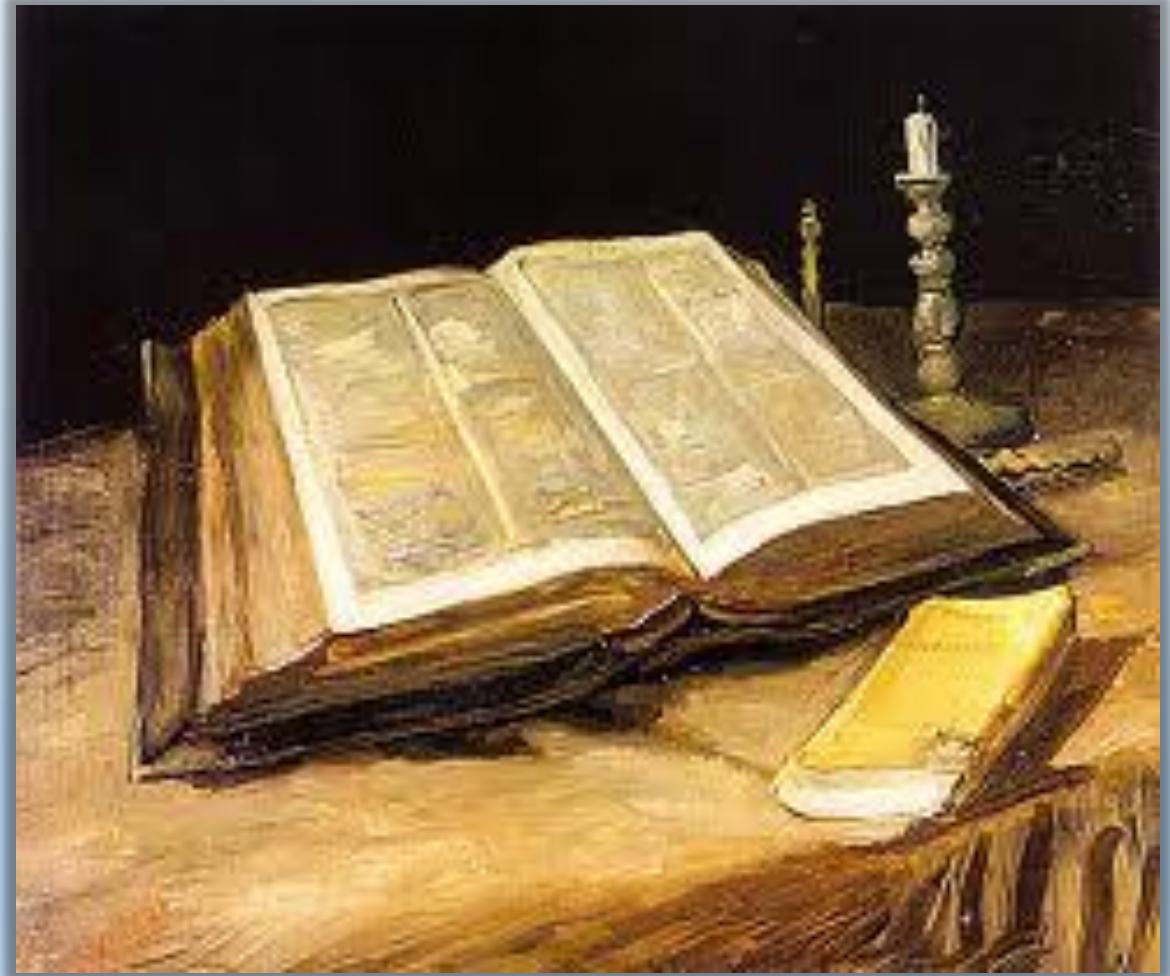
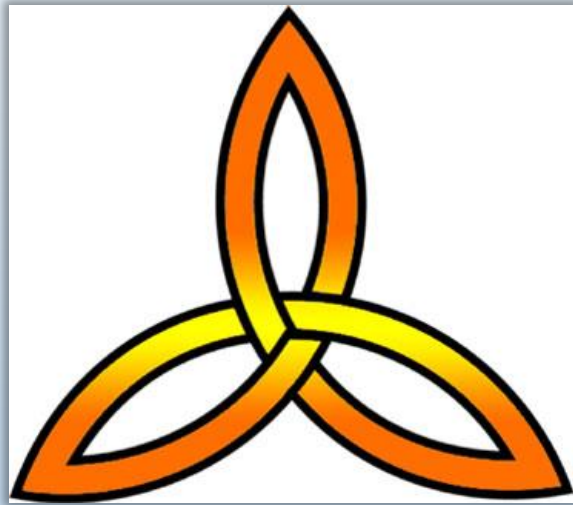
The three members of the Trinity are closely united around the table.

Jesus said to Nicodemus:

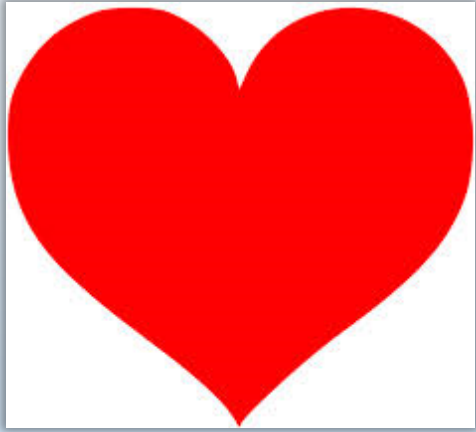
‘God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not be lost but may have eternal life.’
