And he had received an answer from the Holy Spirit: that he would not see his own death before he had seen the Christ of the Lord.


.... And when the child Jesus was brought in by his parents, he also took him up, into his arms, and he blessed God and said:





"Now you may dismiss your servant in peace, O Lord, according to your word.
