Sacraments of First Holy Communion & Confirmation in 2027

Two-year 'Seeds of Faith' Religious Education Classes Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church, Parish of Firhouse

For Parents / Guardians of Catholic Children attending Schools other than Catholic Schools requesting the Sacraments of First Holy Communion & Confirmation, the preparing for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation has changed. Since the end of June 2024, the Diocesan Policy is that there is no longer a one-year preparation of these sacraments, but a two-year preparation called 'Seeds of Faith' which is an after school religious education class of 28 in person classes per year, to bring it in line with the preparation for these Sacraments in Catholic Schools.

A Registration & Request Form needs to be completed and submitted by 25<sup>th</sup> July 2025 by Parents / Guardians of Catholic Children entering in 1<sup>st</sup> Class in September 2025 requesting First Holy Communion, and Catholic Children entering 5<sup>th</sup> Class in September 2025 requesting Confirmation, attending Firhouse Educate Together NS, Gaelscoil na Giúise, or Other, presenting for the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation 2027.

The classes for First Holy Communion will be on Wednesdays 3.15 - 4.15 pm and for Confirmation on Thursdays 3.15 - 4.15 pm starting in mid-September.
