Our plan is to start at 9.30am on Saturday morning, arriving at Glendalough for tea and coffee in God's cottage followed by a tour of the monastic site, but with an option for a more energetic group to be dropped off at Wicklow Gap to walk the last part of St Kevin's Way to Glendalough. There will be time available for those who wish to walk to the Upper lake. We will join together for a picnic lunch, following which we plan to visit St Kevin's Church in Laragh for a Mass or Prayer Service.

We hope to enjoy some final refreshments together before starting our journey back to Dublin.

We are trying to keep costs to a minimum, but do expect the bus to cost in the region of €25. to €30. per person. Those who are able are welcome to make an additional donation to allow us discretion to assist those who may struggle with the cost. Please let us know if you are interested in attending as soon as possible, and ideally before the end of July, with payment due by the first weekend in August.
